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- 2015-2016 FOCUS SCHOOLS Identification and Requirements Focus schools are entering their final year of interventions based on their identification during the 2013-2014 school year.
- 2016-2017 TITLE I, 1003(a) PRIORITY AND FOCUS SCHOOL GRANT
 - Hereford Jr High Met Standards and is identified as a **Focus School**
 - They will participate in support services/events with ESC 16; and
 - Include instructional interventions in the schools 2016-2017 Campus Improvement Plan and provide ESC with access to their plan
 - Hereford High School Met Standards and is identified as a **Focus Progress School**
 - Engage in the Texas Accountability Intervention System (TAIS) continuous improvement process in alignment with the ESEA turnaround principles and Critical Success Factors (CSFs);
 - include instructional interventions in the school's 2016-2017 campus improvement plan and campus will work with their local ESC for training in areas of need.
 - Designate a district and campus contact for focus school support and interventions;
 - Work with the local ESC to:
 - Select, implement and include targeted Instructional interventions designed to close achievement gaps;
 - learn specific focus school project requirements;
 - complete and submit all region-specific project activity documentation; that assess progress and reasons for identification as a focus school;

Participate in at least one initial consultation with the local ESC contact and one additional services/event hosted by the ESC that are listed as a part of the ESC's contractual Focus School Support activity plan. Provide campus and district contact information to the local regional ESC. To receive 1003(a) funds, the district must have identified priority and focus schools and comply with all intervention requirements.
